
- Love Fellowship Church believes the Bible is the inherent and infallible Word of God and the final authority on life.

# THE RELATIONSHIP COVENANT AND CHURCH MEMBERSHIP

#### Church Membership is a Covenant

- 1. Church membership is a covenant between the joining member, the local Church family, and God.
- 2. Covenant is abiding vow or promise between two or more parties and God.
- Church covenant is similar to a marriage covenant. Church membership should not be entered into lightly, just as it is true for the marriage covenant.
- 4. Each member should seek God in prayer prior to connecting in covenant with a local Church family.
- 5. Covenant is for the purpose of giving each party the advantage, not to be taken advantage of. (I Peter 5:1-6; Jeremiah 3:15-16).

## THE RELEVANCY OF THE CHURCH

- I. The Role of the Local Church Today
  - 1. The church is a place of prayer and deliverance (James 5:13-16, Acts 1:14, 12:12).
  - 2. The church is a place of restoration (Galatians 6:1-3).
  - 3. The church is a place of praise and worship unto God (Psalms 149:1).
  - 4. The church is to be a light to the world (Matthew 5:14).
  - 5. The church is place of fellowship (I Peter 4:9).
- II. The Role of the Pastor
  - 1. Minister the Word of God (Romans 10:13-15, Hebrews 13:7).
  - 2. Be a Spiritual father (I Corinthians 4:15).
  - 3. Demonstrate the love and compassion of Christ (I John 3:17).
  - 4. Be a watchman over souls (Hebrews 13:17).
  - 5. Be a resource to the community (Proverbs 3:27).

# REQUIREMENTS OF CHURCH MEMBERSHIP AT LFC

- I. Members must have a personal relationship with Jesus Christ.
  - A. John 3:3-8; Romans 10:9-10
- II. Three T's of Church Membership
  - A. Members should give a significant amount of **Time** to the local church (I Corinthians 4:2).
    - God requires your time in support of all church activities and ministries Romans 12:1, Matthew 26:36-43.
    - God expects you to be on time at every service and event. (Hebrews 13:7; Romans 12:11; Proverbs 6:6-11).
    - You are expected to be accountable to the pastor by texting or calling when you are not going to attend services, especially if you are assigned to duty or responsibility.

## REQUIREMENTS - CONTINUED

- In order to serve in ministry, you must attend services and bible studies on a regular basis.
- B. Members should exercise their **Talents**/Spiritual Gifts within the local church.
  - God expects you to seek Him for revelation regarding what your talents/spiritual gifts are in the Body of Christ (I Corinthians 12:1-11, Romans 12:4-8, Ephesians 4:11-12).
  - Once you discover what your talents/spiritual gifts are God expects you to exercise your gifts both in and outside of the church (I Corinthians 6:19-20).
- C. Members should bring their **Tithe** to the local church (Malachi 3:8-11, Hebrews 7:1-10).
  - Jesus told the people to honor the tithe (Matthew 23:23).
  - Members should give financially out of a cheerful heart (II Corinthians 9:6-7).

#### REQUIREMENTS - CONTINUED

- III. Members Must Honor Church Authority (I Peter 2:13-17).
  - A. Christ is the head of the church (Ephesians 5:23-24).
  - B. The Pastor is the head of the local assembly of believers (John 10:1-5; Hebrews 13:7).
  - C. Members should submit to the leadership of the Church (Titus 2:1-8, I Peter 5:1-5).
- III. Members Should Honor the Ordinances of The Church.
  - A. Water Baptism (John 3:13-17).
  - B. Holy Communion (I Corinthians 11:17-30).
