LFC 2024 Corporate Prayer and Fasting Instructions

1. LFC Corporate Fast will start Monday 1/15 at 6:00 a.m. and end on Tuesday 1/23 at 6:00 a.m. The fasting period will be a time of both spiritual consecration and natural cleansing for each participant of the fast. If you to take medication during the fasting hours, please take your medication.
2. We are asking each member to skip a minimum of 1 meal per day and spend this time in prayer and study of God's Word. Please pray the prayer points in the booklet and your personal prayer points.
3. Each night from 7:30 p.m. to 6:30 a.m. the next morning fast from Food, TV, Movies, and Social Media sites unless it is an emergency, for ministry purposes, meetings, work purposes, or school. Spend this time praying, studying God's Word, and with family.
4. **Call into the LFC prayer line Monday, Wednesday, and Friday at 6:00 a.m. as we pray for the needs of people all around the world! The dial in number is 516-253-3628. No access code required.**
5. **Come out to LFC for Live Prayer on 1/18 at 7:00 p.m.**

6. Come out to Corporate Prayer on 1/21 at 10:15 a.m.

7. Join us for Virtual Prayer on Zoom and Facebook 1/22 at 7:00 p.m.

8. In Psalms 63 (KJV) David teaches God's people how to rise up early in the morning and seek the Lord in prayer, praise and worship. He also teaches them to meditate on God and His Word in the night watches.

- Biblically the night watches are the Uncommon hours of the night when the people of God prayed, praised, worshipped, and meditated.
- The night watches were 9:00 p.m., midnight, 3:00 a.m., and 6:00 a.m. (Matthew 14:25, Psalms 63, Matthew 26:38-40, Acts 16:25-34).
- To pray means to listen to the voice of God as He speaks via the Holy Spirit. It means to talk to God and make your request known to Him. It means to pray in your Heavenly prayer language.
- To Praise God means to thank God for what He has done, what He is doing, and What He is about to do in our lives.

- To Worship God means to declare who He is. To Worship God also means to live a lifestyle that reflects who He is.
- To Meditate means to spend quality time reading and studying God's Word. It means to reflect on the power of the Word. It means to reflect on how the Word changes our lives.

9. Each day confess healing scriptures over your life. Each day confess God's Word over your life! Romans 10:8, 17. Romans 8:31-39. Refer to the LFC Healing Document.

2024 Prayer Points:

I. Day #1 Prayer Points 1/15

- Pray against racism, police brutality, murders, envying, and strife.
- Pray healing will happen in the land as men turn their hearts back to God.
- Pray that diseases will dry up in the land.
- Pray signs, wonders and miracles will begin to manifest in the land.
- Pray that our economy will be healed and restored.
- Pray that the physical lands and waters will be restored to its original states and provide lively hood to the people.
- Pray for Peace in Jerusalem. Pray war would cease in the world.
- Spend quality time studying Matthew 14:22-33, Psalms 63, Acts 16:25-34, Philippians chapter 4, 2 Chronicles 7:14. Confess God's Word over your life daily.

II. Day #2 Prayer Points 1/16

- Pray families will unite together in prayer and follow Christ.
- Pray families will be whole and complete in Christ.
- Pray families will confess daily they can do all things through Christ who strengthen them.

- Pray families around the world would begin to forgive each other of past hurt and disappointments.
- Pray that cycles of ungodly behavior be broken in Jesus name.
- Pray that families will love and care for one another.
- Pray believers will trust God in their finances.
- Pray believers will give God their tithes and offerings.
- Pray increase in wages on jobs.
- Pray every financial need is met in each household.
- Pray God will give us creative ability for finances.
- Pray for increase, excess and overflow to come in our finances.
- Spend quality time studying Joshua 24:14-15, 1 Corinthians 13:4-8, Romans 12:18, Proverbs 3: 9-10, Malachi 3: 10-12, Deuteronomy 8:18. Confess God's Word over your life daily.

III. Day #3 Prayer Points 1/17

- Pray we present our bodies as living sacrifice unto the Lord.
- Pray every person will live a righteous life style before God.
- Pray that we will be vessels of honor.
- Pray that we honor God in every area of our lives.
- Pray that our minds are renewed to serve God daily.
- Pray we give Christ our life daily.
- Pray that every believer will be doers of the Word, and not hearers only.
- Pray that we would repent daily in Christ from unrighteous behaviors.
- Pray that believers will let Christ mind be in them.

- Pray that believers will allow God to correct them and teach them.
- Pray that believers will learn to hear from God.
- Pray spiritual growth will happen daily with every believer.
- Pray that believers will be sensitive to the voice of God.
- Pray believers are teachable and humble.
- Pray that the gifts of God will be made manifest in those that will allow God to grow them up.
- Pray believers will not operate in pride but will be submitted to God and God's authority.
- Spend quality time studying Romans 10, Philippians 2:5, Hebrews 6:1, and Colossians 2:6-7. Confess God's Word over your life daily.

IV. Day #4 Prayer Points 1/18

- Pray for revival in the land.
- Pray that God would send out workers into his harvest field.
- Pray the heart of men will be softened to receive Christ as their Lord and Savior.
- Pray people will be loosed from all bondages and chains that are holding them down and causing them to be out of the will of God.
- Pray freedom from bad habits and mindsets that have kept God's people down.
- Pray every addiction will be loosed from those that are held in bondage.
- Pray that every demonic hold or bondage be broken off our lives in Jesus name.

- Pray that all residues of sin and ungodly thinking, actions, and behaviors are removed from the lives of our love ones, family members, church members and nation.
- Pray that the Stony heart be removed and replaced with a heart of flesh.
- Pray that whomever the lord makes free remains free in Jesus name.
- Pray that the rebellion is bound and cannot operate in anyone wanting to get free and live for Christ.
- Study Matthew 9: 35-38, 2 Peter 3:9, Psalms 51, Psalms 68:20, Deuteronomy 20:4. Allow God to minister to you through His Word.

V. Day #5 Prayer Points 1/19

- Pray our children be taught of the Lord and great will be their peace.
- Pray a hedge of protection around our children.
- Pray that our children will submit to authority.
- Pray our children will honor their mothers and fathers.
- Pray our children will be filled with the Holy Spirit.

- Pray that God will be the head of our children's lives. Isaiah 54:13, Exodus 20:12, John 10:27. Allow God to minister to you through His Word.
- Pray for unity, peace, and justice to prevail in the United States.
- Pray for the upcoming elections. Pray the people God desires gets into elected office.
- Pray against racism, police brutality, murders, envying, and strife.

VI. Day #6 Prayer Points 1/20
